If you object to a foreclosure of the above-mentioned property <u>on that basis</u>, then you or your attorney must file a written appearance and answer in this court at **Three Pemberton Square**, **Boston**, **MA 02108** on or before <u>February 3, 2025</u> or you may lose the opportunity to challenge the foreclosure on the grounds of noncompliance with the Act.
